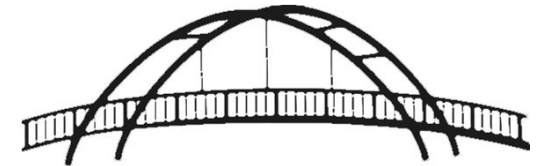

## Welcome to the neighborhood!

The Tenney-Lapham Neighborhood offers the charm and vitality that only a traditional city neighborhood can provide. You can work, shop, dine, and play all within a short walk from any home in this historic, centrally located community. It is a neighborhood that strives to maintain a diverse population, a variety of housing opportunities, and a high quality of living for all of its residents. It doesn't matter if you are a child, a college student, a young professional, a senior citizen or a parent of a kid at Lapham, Marquette, O'Keefe, or East High - Tenney-Lapham is a great place to live.

A wide range of housing options are found in different areas of the neighborhood, including large homes with lake frontage, smaller, moderately priced homes, co-op living, two/three flats and large apartment buildings.

Accessibility to Lake Mendota and the Yahara River for water activities and the linkage to the bike system provide a wide range of recreational and transportation opportunities. Four city parks - James Madison, Reynolds, Tenney and Giddings -along with the Yahara River Parkway, offer a variety of resources, including beaches, an ice skating rink, and volleyball and tennis courts.

The economic heart of the neighborhood lies along East Johnson Street and East Washington Avenue, where you can shop for groceries, do your laundry, get a haircut, have your bike repaired, visit great restaurants, coffee shops, and stores, and much more.

There is so much going on here in Tenney-Lapham Neighborhood. We hope you'll be a part of it.

## Why should I join TLNA?

- TLNA provides a voice for residents when working with the city on issues important to the neighborhood such as transportation, safety, housing, community service and parks.
- TLNA provides financial support to parts of the neighborhood that enrich our lives such as our schools, our parks, and our businesses.
- TLNA helps build a sense of community through the distribution of the newsletter, hosting a listserv, sponsoring social events, and creating opportunities to socialize with neighbors.

## What are the membership levels?

The cost of a single adult membership (ages 18-64) is \$10/year. If you are a senior (age 65 or older) or a student, the cost is \$5/year. For a neighborhood business or a household, the cost of membership is \$20/year.

## How are dues used?

- Dues help support important initiatives at our schools (Lapham, Marquette, O'Keefe, and East High Schools) and our parks.
- Dues fund our neighborhood grant program.
- Dues are used to publish a great neighborhood newsletter.
- Dues support our neighborhood events.
