MAJOR Impact – 5:00 AM – 6:00 PM

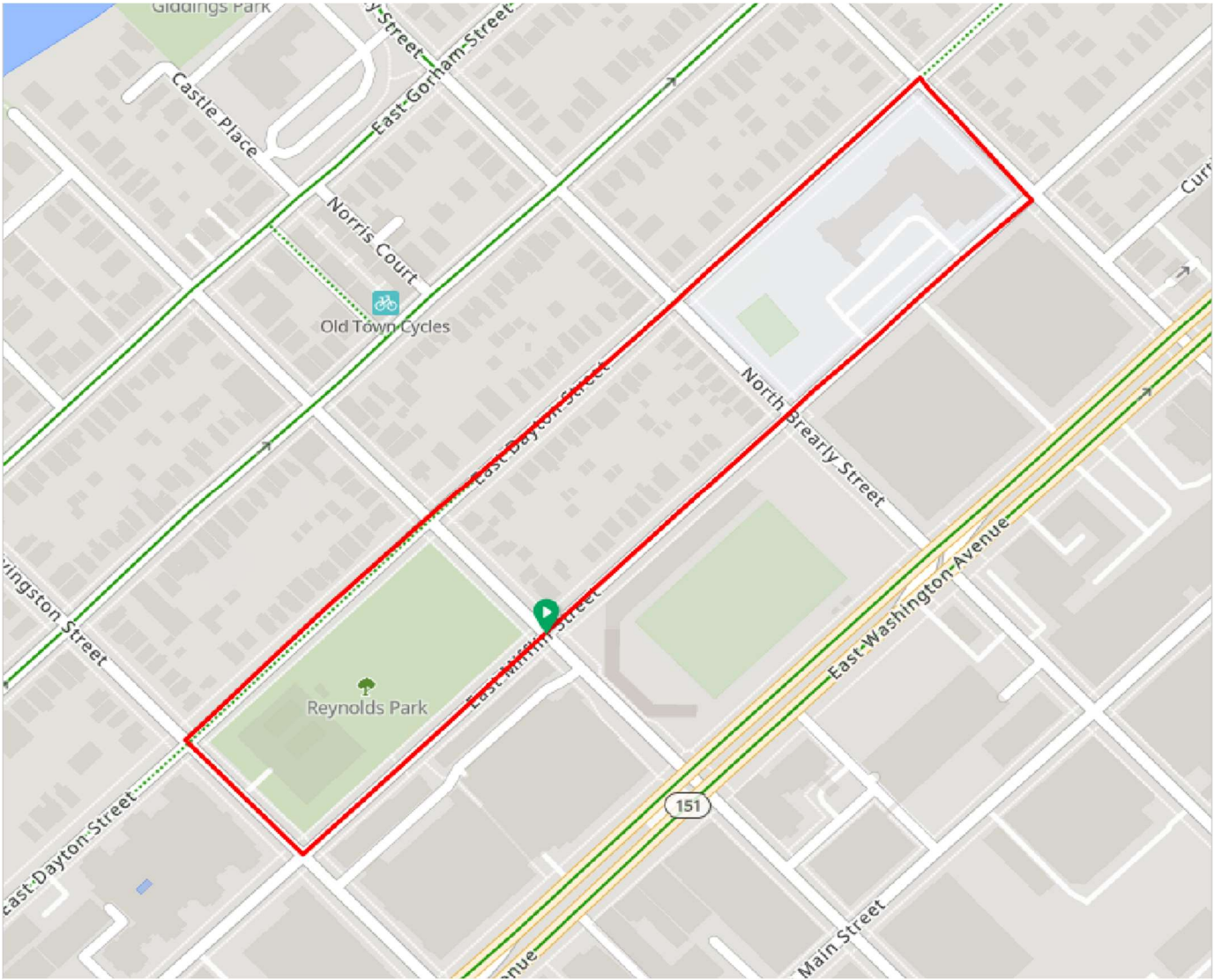
N. Livingston, E. Dayton, N. Ingersoll, and E. Mifflin portions of the racecourse will be **inaccessible by vehicle**

2025 Collegiate Road Nationals – Criterium – May 3, 2025

Major impact to you: Saturday, May 3 – Sunday, May 4, 2025

Sunday, May 4, the Criterium will happen in the City of Madison. We have support from the City of Madison, Madison Fire & Police Department, Madison Parks Department, and the Tenney Lapham Neighborhood Association for the use of N. Livingston, E. Dayton, N. Ingersoll, and E. Mifflin streets. The race will start and finish near the corner of N. Patterson and E. Mifflin. A map of the course is below.

Implications to you on Saturday, May 3 and Sunday, May 4, 2025

We apologize for any inconvenience caused to you during this race and appreciate your cooperation in allowing the National Championship Road Race to be hosted here. **Vehicular access to race course roads (N. Livingston, E. Dayton, N. Ingersoll, and E. Mifflin streets) will be closed during racing. We ask that you do not park on the street and understand that your driveway will be inaccessible during racing on Sunday, May 4.** Pedestrian access will be available at multiple locations throughout the course; all sidewalks will remain open. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Schedule of Events

Setup – Our staff will be setting up race materials (fencing, etc.) starting at **8pm Saturday, May 3.**

E Mifflin St between N Patterson & N Brearly will be closed until event completion on Sunday at 6pm. **Please do not park your vehicles on the street.** No Parking signs will be placed by the city of Madison. These locations will be **tow-zones**; please respect the posted signs. **Should you need to use your vehicle parked at your residence Saturday, May 3 after 8PM through Sunday, May 4 at 6pm, please utilize the alternate residential parking available at Turn Key Supper Club for residents who need it (1344 E Washington Ave).**

Setup will continue **Sunday, May 4, beginning at 5am** when racecourse roadways (N. Livingston, E. Dayton, N. Ingersoll, and E. Mifflin streets) will be inaccessible by vehicle. **Please do not park your vehicles on the street.** No Parking signs will be placed by the city of Madison. These locations will be **tow-zones**; please respect the posted signs. **Should you need to use your vehicle parked at your residence Sunday, May 4 from 5am-6pm, please utilize the alternate residential parking available at Turn Key Supper Club for residents who need it (1344 E Washington Ave).** We thank you for ensuring all vehicles are moved prior to 5am Sunday, May 4.

Roads are closed from 5am – 6pm. Racing will be from 9am – 4pm. Vehicular access to N. Livingston, E. Dayton, N. Ingersoll, and E. Mifflin streets will be closed throughout the race; pedestrian access is available all day. Please respect course closure signage and staff. We appreciate your understanding and compliance to keep all athletes and staff safe.

Teardown will begin immediately following the conclusion of the race (**around 4pm Sunday, May 4**) with priority set to reopen the roads starting with E. Mifflin and N. Ingersoll and working west. Please be aware of our staff and race materials.
